# **July Beginner Match**

The July beginner match saw one of the hottest days of the year so far. We started the match earlier than usual so that we finished before the real heat of the day set in. Eighteen shooters braved the heat and six brought along a second gun.

As is our usual this year, Ron Lohman set up three 18-shot stages and one walk & shoot stage. The three standing stages included a variety of paper, bowling pins, and steel. On one stage that featured the Texas Star, Ron set up a large steel plate in front of the bottom plate on the star. The large plate was the "Last Shot" for this stage and shooters needed to time the swinging plates on the star so as to miss the large plate. Shooters who hit the large plate before all five plates were off the star lost points.

The walk and shoot stage featured short stops along the way. Shooters needed to count shots and remember to reload while walking from one target area to the next. The last part of this stage included two 40 yard shots along with six shots at the plate rack. Ron limited shooters to one minute and 20 seconds and several shooters were unable to complete the stage in the required time.

Our next match will be held Saturday, August 8th. We ask shooters to arrive at 8 AM and help finish setting up the match. Also, Ron needs help Friday afternoon when he sets up most of the match. Gerold Trusty, Ron's "trusty" helper got a new job and can't make the Friday setup any longer. Rick Walker, CCRP club member, helped Ron set up the July match and earned hours toward his club assessment fee. Our goal is to be ready to shoot before 9 AM and finished with the match by 12 or 1 PM.

For new shooters and first time shooters please bring your favorite center fire revolver or semi-auto pistol, at least 100 rounds of ammo, along with a belt and hip holster. You will also need at least three speed loaders or magazines. If you don't have any equipment, come on out anyway and try out a gun or two before you buy one of your own. We have spare equipment available for those just starting out.

#### <u>MEMBERSHIP DUES RATES</u> Dues and Renewal policies are effective September 1, 2003

Members will receive a statement 45 days before their membership expires. (Your renewal month is found on your mailing label.) The dues renewal date is the last day of the month in which members' "annual date" falls. Members' gate card will automatically "lock out" on their renewal date if they have not renewed, and their membership will be considered "inactive" for 30-days, during which time they may still pay their dues. After 30-days on "inactive" status the membership will be terminated. Should they wish to rejoin CCR&P past the 30-days "inactive" status, they must reapply as a new member and attend the Orientation class. **Membership fees**, collected at the time of the orientation classes are:

Annual dues \$70.00 for the first member of each household and \$35.00 for each

additional eligible member of the household.

Initiation fee (one time) \$80.00 for each household and a refundable gate card deposit

fee of **\$10.00** for each member.

In addition, each member is expected to devote 8 hours of volunteer service annually

or recruit two new members or pay an assessment of \$80.00.
