The day started, after range set up assisted by Doug Simpson, John Vladeff and Tony Yaklich, with a brief shooter's meeting to catch up on advance planning for Rain Dee Voo 2010. Booshway BO Brown recapped the planning meeting results. John Vladeff confirmed his intent to handle the novelty matches. Discussion agreed to have only club-house vicinity activities for the Under 12's. Informal shooting for Under 12's could be arranged under parental supervision but only scheduled range activity for them would be the one-shot buffalo hunt Saturday morning at 10:00 AM. There is still a need for a trail boss and trail monitors, and Trade Chief activity needs to have Steve Andrews' concurrence and acceptance. Raffle ticket sales were opened and tickets are available for anyone desiring to sell them off the range.

The match shooting proceeded at the usual variety of targets, with rifle targets featuring deer hunting in honor of the current hunting season. At the conclusion of the events, near noon, those participating received awards including a furnished aggregate blanket, and match prizes donated by the Victor Rodriguez family. BO Brown triumphed in the luck shoot with an indisputable dead center shot. Match awards, an assortment of decorative pumpkins went to: Trade Gun: Don Kerr, 1st, Mike Nesbitt 2nd, and Bob DeLisle 3rd. Rifle prizes: Mike Nesbitt 1st, Bob DeLisle 2nd & Don Kerr 3rd. <u>MEMBERSHIP DUES RATES</u> Dues and Renewal policies are effective September 1, 2003

Members will receive a statement 45 days before their membership expires. (Your renewal month is found on your mailing label.) The dues renewal date is the last day of the month in which members' "annual date" falls. Members' gate card will automatically "lock out" on their renewal date if they have not renewed, and their membership will be considered "inactive" for 30-days, during which time they may still pay their dues. After 30-days on "inactive" status the membership will be terminated. Should they wish to rejoin CCR&P past the 30-days "inactive" status, they must reapply as a new member and attend the Orientation class. **Membership fees**, collected at the time of the orientation classes are:

Annual dues \$70.00 for the first member of each household and \$35.00 for each

additional eligible member of the household.

Initiation fee (one time) \$80.00 for each household and a refundable gate card deposit

fee of **\$10.00** for each member.

In addition, each member is expected to devote 8 hours of volunteer service annually

or recruit two new members or pay an assessment of \$80.00.

(<u>GUESTS:</u> Members may bring their spouses and children under the age of 18 years old <u>as guests</u> as often as they'd like. Non-immediate family member guests are limited to two visits annually. Members **MUST** accompany their guests at all times, including spouses and children, and are responsible for the conduct of their guests.)
