M1 Garand Match Results

July 10, 2011

Sunday morning had calm winds and near perfect temperature making for a great day of shooting. We had eight turn out for our 3rd match this season. A few folks had some mechanical issues, but everyone seemed to enjoy the event. Gary Thorson won the Prone Slow Fire Stage with a score of 193 5x. Gary's overall score suffered in the end as a result of having a loose rear sight. Fran Huntington won both the Prone Rapid and Sitting Rapid Fire Stages, with Tony Miner taking the Off-Hand Stage. Sundays overall Match win went to Ken Horton with a score of 439 6x. Nice job Ken!

Old Soldier Match

June 26, 2011

There was a good turn out of 12 shooters who came out in good weather to shoot at 200 yards from the prone position. The temperature was in the mid to high 60's with sunshine and very little wind. The military type "dog tag" award went to the top three places.

First place went to Tony Minerd (again) with a 290-10x using a M1 Garand. Second went to Gary Thorson with a score of 286-4x. Gary shot a US 1903-A3. Third went to Gary Baldwin with a 281-5x using a US 1903. There were only 9 points between 1st and 3rd place. There was a tie for Fourth and Fifth with a 271-6x with David Larson edging out Mike Hadley by using the highest first string score as the tie breaker. Good shooting guys.

Brett Bittrick, second time shooter, shot a Mosin-Nagant Model 91/59 with surplus Russian ammo for a score of 265-4x for Sixth. Nice shooting Brett! Seventh & Eighth were close behind.

It was great to see some new faces at this match. Those of you who haven't been out for awhile, come on out and knock Tony off the podium at the next match.

Harvey came wearing a former communist bloc uniform to go along with shooting a Mosin-Nagant.

After the Old Solder Match there were 6 shooters for the Carbine match. The course of fire was an "Official 100 Yard Military Type Target" at 50 yards and 100 yards. The target has a 5.5 inch bull and a 1.75 inch V ring (like an X ring). At 100 yards, 10 rounds were shot slow fire (2 minutes) from prone and 10 shots rapid fire prone (1 minute). At 50 yards, 10 shots rapid fire (1 minute) in sitting position and 10 shots from standing (2 minutes). The highest score wins out of a possible 200 points. First went to Ken Horton with a 183-5v using an AR-15, M4 Carbine. Harvey overwhelmed (maybe under-whelmed) Gary Thorson for Second by 1 more "V" with a score of 172-2v using a .22 LR M1 Carbine clone. Gary Thorson was Third with a 172-1v using an AR-15 Carbine.

MEMBERSHIP DUES RATES

Dues and Renewal policies are effective September 1, 2003

Members will receive a statement 45 days before their membership expires. (Your renewal month is found on your mailing label.) The dues renewal date is the last day of the month in which members' "annual date" falls. Members' gate card will automatically "lock out" on their renewal date if they have not renewed, and their membership will be considered "inactive" for 30-days, during which time they may still pay their dues. After 30-days on "inactive" status the membership will be terminated. Should they wish to rejoin CCR&P past the 30-days "inactive" status, they must reapply as a new member and attend the Orientation class. **Membership fees**, collected at the time of the orientation classes are:

Annual dues **\$70.00** for the first member of each household and **\$35.00** for each additional eligible member of the household.

Initiation fee (one time) **\$80.00** for each household and a refundable gate card deposit fee of **\$10.00** for each member.

In addition, each member is expected to devote 8 hours of volunteer service annually or recruit two new members or pay an assessment of **\$80.00**.

(GUESTS: Members may bring their spouses and children under the age of 18 years old **as guests** as often as they'd like. Non-immediate family member guests are limited to two visits annually. Members **MUST** accompany their guests at all times, including spouses and children, and are responsible for the conduct of their guests.)

Dig out that old military rifle from storage and come on out and have some fun. Shooters fire 30 shots (for score) at 200 yard from the prone position, using an issued military rifle. The rifles have been from the 19th and 20th Century (Springfield 1903 & A3, 30-40 Krag, M1 Garand, Mauser's of various countries and calibers, Swiss K31, British No 1 and 4 and Mosin-Nagant's but not AR 15).
