Note: If this event has an application on file for 2012,2013,2014 this sheet is all that is necessary for renewal. The next full renewal will be required in 2015. Event Applications are required for meetings including New Member Training, Hunter Education on the range. This lead sheet is all that is necessary for Meeting Events.

Purpose:

This Event Application is to assist the applicant through the development on the event or match. Also it will establish scheduling in accordance with club activities. This will minimize conflicts and maximize club property use.

Submittal Order

- 1. Applicant submits Event Application to Range Director for approval.
- 2. Applicant forwards Event Application to Safety Officer for Approval, 2 copies. .
- 3. Safety Officer forwards approved Application to Scheduler for verification of club activities surrounding the event.

Events other than matches:

This Event application is needed for other events other than matches. The use of the kitchen and indoor range are important activities and do cause conflicts. If the event is a non shooting event only the lead page is only needed.

Description of Event:

Purpose of Event:

Name facilities that will not be access able due to the event.

Qualified personnel:

Those individuals in charge of events need to be reminded that if particular qualifications are necessary for help they will be required to accomplish those needs. An example is Food Handlers Permits and certifications.

New shooters shall have specific instruction. Scorers, RSO, Range Officers and Supervisor will deem necessary monitoring of new shooters. Equipment:

Individual equipment shall be in good condition. Shooting can be deemed over by the Range Officer when individual equipment malfunctions.

The Match Director will indicate governing Rules such as: NMLRA, NRA, WSR&PA, SASS, Thurston County Health Dept. Regulations and others applicable.

Generally speaking a match or event conducted under an approved CCR&P SOP and our standard range rules is covered by our club liability policy. The CCR&P and the NRA cover a match conducted under an approved CCR&P Sop and NRA shooting discipline rules. Participants who are not CCR&P members will complete a liability release. Also matches shall be proceeded by a safety meeting. Match Procedure:

This statement is the basic schedule of activities of the shoot and event. It shall include the course of fire for the match and fees. This may be done in a variety of ways. It can be done after the Safety meeting. It may be posted. If the course of fire is an accepted course with very limited changes this will be sufficient. The course maybe a walk through.

MEMBERSHIP DUES RATES Dues and Renewal policies

Members will receive a statement 45 days before their membership expires. (Your renewal month is found on your mailing label.) The dues renewal date is the last day of the month in which members' "annual date" falls. Members' gate card will automatically "lock out" on their renewal date if they have not renewed, and their membership will be considered "inactive" for 30-days, during which time they may still pay their dues. After 30-days on "inactive" status the membership will be terminated. Should they wish to rejoin CCR&P past the 30-days "inactive" status, they must reapply as a new member and attend the Orientation class. **Membership fees (taxes are additional)**, collected at the time of the orientation classes are:

Annual dues \$70.00 for the first member of each household and \$35.00 for each

additional eligible member of the household.

Initiation fee (one time) \$80.00 for each household and a refundable gate card deposit

fee of \$10.00 for each member.

In addition, each member is expected to devote 8 hours of volunteer service annually

or recruit two new members or pay an assessment of \$80.00.

NRA membership (required)

Orientation class (required)

(<u>GUESTS:</u> Members may bring their spouses and children under the age of 18 years old <u>as guests</u> as often as they'd like. Non-immediate family member guests are limited to two visits annually. Members **MUST** accompany their guests at all times, including spouses and children, and are responsible for the conduct of their guests.)
