### Wednesday Night Indoor .22 Rifle Instructional League

Do you want to practice and improve your rifle shooting during the cold, dark, rainy winter? Well, we have a deal for you.

Every Wednesday evening at 6:30 PM beginning in October and running through the end of March, we will be opening the Indoor Range for .22 rifle shooting. This will be for CCRP Club Members only. The gate will not be locked open, and you will need your key card to get in. There is no charge for this event, and targets will be provided. When we run out of targets, we'll all chip in to buy some more.

This will be a semi-formal shooting session on the Indoor Range, with targets at 50 feet. NRA certified Range Safety Officers will be present to run the line. We usually run four 10-minute firing sessions, with plenty of time between sessions to change targets, chat with your friends, and warm up next to the wood stove. We typically shoot prone, sitting, kneeling, and standing positions. But you can shoot any position you wish.

You can use any .22 rifle you wish; .22 short, long, or long rifle. No magnums, please. Open sights or scope. If you use a semi-auto rifle, please remember that this is target shooting, so no "Mag-dump blasting" will be allowed.

Starting in January, several of the regular shooters will form a team to participate in the National Rifle League postal league competition. You are welcome to join the team, or if you want to just come and shoot for fun, that's fine.

The course of fire for the league is all slow fire, 10 shots in 10 minutes. We shoot four 10-minute stages; prone, sitting, kneeling, and standing. Scores are submitted online to the league web site. There are usually around 35 teams from all over the U.S. and Canada participating in the league.

Come out and join us. It sure beats watching TV.

### **Brass into Gold**

A question came up that maybe not everybody knows the answer. As most of us when we shoot, we sweep up our unwanted brass and dump it into a bucket. OK. Bob Greenman told me the other day that "they", a group of High School small bore shooter enthusiasts, are supporting the shooters by recycling the brass. It's almost that simple. Indoors it is no problem they place clean .22 brass in a container and deliver it to the recycle center. Great. Outdoors it is different. First, they separate the brass into centerfire, rimfire, and nickel. Of course, there is a certain amount of debris that has to be removed. Now when the amount is worth the volunteer trip to the Tacoma recycle plus the donated fuel. It is sold. Bob said in the few years they have been doing it they have banked for the teams about \$3700. Wow. Today when sweeping up I worked at removing unwanted debris. On the side bay at High Power there are separate buckets. Maybe we should lend Bob and supporters a hand and try and get it in the proper buckets. Good job Bob and friends.

#### **COVID**

Because of Covid, we have some guidelines and goals we would like to work toward:

- It is each individual's responsibility to follow COVID guidelines and protect themselves from communicable diseases.
- If you are sick, please stay home. If you think you are susceptible, consider staying home.
- We want to try to keep one shooting lane separation from each other on the firing line. Household types can buddy up on a table.
- We recommend wearing a face mask if you are in the meeting room.
- Shooters will be self-scoring (and not sharing/touching each other's targets).

Please respond if you intend to shoot some or all of the league so we can map out what attendance will look like.

#### SCORING/PRIZES

Because of this, this will not be an NRA Sanctioned League this winter, and instead, we will award prizes in two categories: Marksman and Sharpshooter/Expert (combined). Typical rules for an NRA course of fire will be followed (6 – 10 shot relays (2 Slow Fire, 2 Timed, 2 Rapid)).

- For Pistol, it will be your best (5) scores.
- · For Revolver, it will be your best (2) scores.

#### **ACCESS**

New club rule. The gate is to remain closed during matches. Have your access card handy. If you are a non-member attending, please get ahold of me and we will work out access.

#### **MISC**

The first relay is at 6:30pm and the second relay at just before 7:30pm.

Please note, you can shoot either or both relays for score.

The Covid Winter League fee is \$30 (includes sales tax).

Shooters can also pay the fee and shoot for fun, one or two handed.

Come out and shoot for score or just practice. Please forward this email to anyone you think may want to attend.

# MEMBERSHIP DUES RATES Dues and Renewal policies

Members will receive a statement 45 days before their membership expires. (Your renewal month is found on your mailing label.) The dues renewal date is the last day of the month in which members' "annual date" falls. Members' gate card will automatically "lock out" on their renewal date if they have not renewed, and their membership will be considered "inactive" for 30-days, during which time they may still pay their dues. After 30-days on "inactive" status the membership will be terminated. Should they wish to rejoin CCR&P past the 30-days "inactive" status, they must reapply as a new member and attend the Orientation class. Membership fees (taxes are additional), collected at the time of the orientation classes are:

Annual dues \$70.00 for the first member of each household and \$35.00 for each

additional eligible member of the household.

Initiation fee (one time) \$80.00 for each household and a refundable gate card deposit

fee of \$10.00 for each member.

In addition, each member is expected to devote 8 hours of volunteer service annually

or recruit two new members or pay an assessment of \$80.00.

NRA membership (required)

Orientation class (required)

(<u>GUESTS:</u> Members may bring their spouses and children under the age of 18 years old <u>as quests</u> as often as they'd like. Non-immediate family member guests are limited to two visits annually. Members **MUST** accompany their guests at all times, including spouses and children, and are responsible for the conduct of their guests.)
